CONFERENCE VENUE AND ACCOMMODATION

Dear Delegates,

We are pleased to communicate the Conference Venue and Accommodation arrangement from the date of arrival to departure, 12-18 March 2023.

Local organisers have come up with an excellent arrangement to make your stay memorable.

1). On arrival in Kathmandu at Tribhuvan International Airport: Pre-paid Taxi service is available from the Tribhuvan International airport to your desired location. An airport pickup by the hotel can be requested at a cost in addition to individual car renting. Details of such services will be in the next announcement.

The conference venue is at the hotel.

2) Conference on 13 and 14th March (Monday and Tuesday) will be held in a 4-star hotel Mystic Mountain, Nagarkot. <https://www.hotelmysticmountain.com/>

Several delegates will arrive on 12th March, and some may plan earlier too. However, the same tariff applies.

Nagarkot is about 30 km from the airport, and it is at the rim of the Kathmandu Valley. It is known for its spectacular views of the Himalayas, including Mount Everest, and especially for the striking sunrise and sunset.

Nagarkot is chosen to provide a panoramic view of mount Everest and the majestic Himalayan range without that visit to Nepal is incomplete.

3). On 15th March, Wednesday, we will come to Kathmandu, and the organisers will provide a free bus service to take the delegates to the next accommodation.

From 15th-17th March (Wednesday to Friday), 5-star hotel Yak and Yeti, Kathmandu, is reserved, <https://www.yakandyeti.com/>

In 1977, the former Royal Palace was opened as the 5-star hotel Yak and Yeti. Rich in Heritage and Legacy, the Imperial Palace was built in 1885 by one of the most powerful kings of Nepal, Maharaja Bir Shumsher Jung Bahadur Rana. The hotel preserves amazing original royal interiors.

Delegates may leave on 18th March or as per their programme.

Details of the Schedules for the 15th March will be given later. The planning includes Laboratory visits at the University, a forum on scientific activity, and a banquet in the evening.

4) On 16th and 17th March (Thursday and Friday) conference will be held in hotel Yak and Yeti.
